Our September 14th speaker is Steve Wittrock, Captain USCG (ret). Wittrock was the Commanding Officer of the US Coast Guard Cutter Katherine Walker, homeported in Bayonne NJ on September 11th, 2001. After he and his crew watched the tragic events unfold, they quickly responded as one of the first Coast Guard cutters on scene. Wittrock will discuss the immediate response to support the safe maritime evacuation of a half million persons off the island of Manhattan along with recovery operations followed by the emerging security concerns in NY Harbor and all ports throughout the nation. Captain Wittrock will then highlight the transformation that the Coast Guard went through over the next several years up to today to meet the challenges of the new understanding of potential security threats in the maritime environment.

USCG Cutter James Paterson Commissioning

August 10 was an important day for our USCG Sector with the commissioning of *USCG Cutter James Paterson* in Portland. Club President Wendy Lull was invited to attend the very moving ceremony. The ship was brought to life as the command was given to her Commanding Officer, Lt. Vaughn Gehman and her crew. "It was an honor to attend this event. When the order was given to Break the Admiral's flag, you could feel the pride and sense of great responsibility of her crew. That sense was carried through during the tour. Everyone we spoke to was eager to put their new training and the ship's new capabilities to work. EM1 Vennevel showed off the control panel for "her" two 20-cylindar MTR marine diesel engines that can take that ship up to 28 knots."

The Sentinal-class is the next generation of patrol boats, and game-changer for the CG surface fleet. These Fast Response Cutters (FRCs) serve search and rescue, counter drug, migrant interdiction, fisheries regulations management and homeland security missions--every USCG mission except ice breaking. The FRC is 154 ft, 353 long tons and draws 9.5 feet and has about 4 miles of wires to accommodate her advanced electronics and communications. She is able to perform multi-day patrols, accommodate mixed gender crews in far more comfortable conditions specifically designed to improve morale and thus efficiency on long patrols. She is armed with four crewserved machine guns and a remotely operated chain gun.

The next commissioning of these new FRCs in our coast guard sector will be here in Portsmouth in October.
